PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requests Council approval to accept grant funding from the NC Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ) State Fiscal Recovery Funds grant to aid in the design of the Fairview Street Stormwater Control Measure (SCM) retrofit. Council approval is requested for a budget ordinance to permit the expenditure of funds.

BACKGROUND:

The City has received an Offer and Acceptance letter from NCDEQ for American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding in the amount of \$375,000 for the Fairview Street SCM retrofit design. The City has an ongoing contract (contract number 2023-0220) with Schnabel Engineering South, P.C. for the design of a dam rehabilitation alternative at the Fairview Street site for \$270,720. The City is also in the process of finalizing an agreement with Schnabel Engineering South, P.C. for the design of the SCM retrofit with a total project sum of \$164,268 (contract number 2023-0600). This ARP funding will cover \$20,440 of the 2023-0220 contract and the entirety of the 2023-0600 contract.

BUDGET IMPACT:

This grant funding will increase the Water Resources Grant Fund budget by \$375,000. Funding in the amount of \$250,280 will be needed from the Water Resources Stormwater Capital Improvement Fund to supplement the portion of the 2023-0220 contract that is not covered by grant funding.
