SUBJECT: M/WBE Memo for 2023-0010 (11438) Resurfacing of Streets 2023,

Change Order 1

The M/WBE Office reviewed the change order request for contract 2023-0010 (11438) Resurfacing of Streets 2023 to determine compliance with the City's M/WBE Program Plan. The contractor is required to maintain the M/WBE participation throughout the duration of the contract unless approved in advance by the City.

On December 20, 2022, Council approved to award Blythe Construction, Inc. a contract for \$10,226,838.61. The firm committed to utilizing MBE 10.50% (\$1,073,818.05) and WBE 18.70% (\$1,912,418.82). Change Order #1 for \$4,205,057.18 will increase the total contract amount to \$14,431,895.79. The overall M/WBE utilization will change to MBE 12.89% and WBE 16.31%. The contract continues to comply with the M/WBE Program Plan and the firm proposed to commit \$1,227,876.69 or 29.20% of the change order amount to the following M/WBE firms:
