PURPOSE:

The Greensboro Police Department has received funds from the NC Department of Revenue Unauthorized Substances Tax proceeds in the amount of \$75,000. The department wishes to use the grant funds for service contracts not included in their general fund budget. Approval of the budget ordinance is requested from the Greensboro City Council in accordance with current city fiscal procedures.

BACKGROUND:

The Greensboro Police Department is starting an initiative to utilize State Drug Tax proceeds to strategically address root causes of crime through support of Community Based Organizations. Over the next 3 years, the police department will support a community based organization with a proven record in addressing the root causes of crime at the community level with up to \$25,000 in funding each fiscal year. The community based organization, Establishing Safe Cultures, will be awarded this inaugural funding to support a 9 -month program that is designed to address increasing violence among Black and Brown youth in Greensboro. This will be accomplished by providing extracurricular activities, mentoring, counseling and other life enriching experiences.

Vision Statement: “A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life.”

NCGS 105-113.105 allows local law enforcement agencies to share in the NC Department of Revenue Unauthorized Substances Tax proceeds. The NC Department of Revenue distributes a percentage of the excise tax proceeds to the local law enforcement agency whose investigation led to the assessment.
