PURPOSE:

A resolution is needed to authorize a municipal agreement with NC Department of Transportation for U-5850 Randleman Road Improvements sidewalk maintenance.

BACKGROUND:

Project U-5850 is a state funded transportation improvement project to widen Randleman Road from Glendale Drive to Elmsley Drive. This roadway serves multiple commercial destinations including Food Lion, CVS, First Citizens Bank, and numerous small businesses. Added pedestrian infrastructure improvements including sidewalks will improve safety and increase access to transit and nearby business for residents and visitors.

NCDOT will be responsible for constructing new sidewalks within project limits following standard departmental policies and procedures. This municipal agreement transfers maintenance responsibility and liability for the sidewalk to be constructed under U-5850 to the City. No conflicts with municipally-owned utilities are expected at this time, but future supplemental agreements may be necessary if conflicts are found.
