**PURPOSE:**

A resolution is needed to authorize a municipal agreement with NCDOT for U-6016 Lewiston Road and Fleming Road Intersection Improvements sidewalk maintenance.

**BACKGROUND:**

Project U-6016 is a state funded transportation improvement project to add turning lanes and sidewalk at the intersection of Lewiston Road (SR 2124) and Fleming Road (SR 2136). This intersection serves multiple commercial destinations including Food Lion, Dollar General, and the Cardinal Crossing Shopping Center. Added pedestrian infrastructure improvements will improve safety at the intersection and increase access to nearby business for residents and visitors.

NCDOT will be responsible for constructing new sidewalk within project limits following standard departmental policies and procedures. This municipal agreement transfers maintenance responsibility and liability for the sidewalk to be constructed under U-6016 to the City. No conflicts with municipally-owned utilities are expected at this time, but future supplemental agreements may be necessary if conflicts are found.
