PURPOSE:

Guilford Metro 911 is requesting approval to Amendment #15 for the 800 MHz interlocal agreement with Guilford County.

BACKGROUND:

Guilford Metro 911 and Guilford County have collaborated in a joint public safety radio system since 1995 in an effort to benefit the communications of public safety responders. This alliance shares the costs equally between the parties, affording the ability to maintain a reliable emergency response system. BUDGET IMPACT:

Funding collected by the City from Guilford County, will cover 50% of the five year expense of \$7,209,386.86, to maintain the public safety radio system, which will be deposited into various Guilford Metro 911 accounts.
