PURPOSE:

The Property Management Section of the Engineering and Inspections Department is in the process of purchasing property for the Vandalia Road Widening Project.

BACKGROUND:

The subject property is located at 3800 Riverdale Road, Parcel #134985. The property is owned by Jeanette Anderson Scott. The location of this property will allow for the construction of a new sidewalk and bike lane. The property was recently appraised by D. Lynn Cable, MAI, an independent appraiser, for a value of \$60,450. The owner has agreed to accept the appraised amount.

The property is zoned RS-30, Residential. The required property consists of 50,094 Sq. Ft. (1.15 acres).
