### **PURPOSE:**

The City of Greensboro has received a Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) Grant in the amount of \$416,000 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to support eligible expenses for one (1) Replacement Electric Bus. A budget ordinance must be approved to allow the expenditures.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The CMAQ program funds transportation related environmental projects for areas in nonattainment or maintenance for ozone, carbon monoxide, and/or particulate matter. The City will use the \$416,000 in Federal funds to purchase one (1) Electric Bus to replace a diesel bus that was a total loss due to an electrical fire.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

The City will be required to provide local matching funds in the amount of \$73,411.

The City will also provide \$220,871 from insurance proceeds of which \$183,323 represents the Federal share, and \$37,548 is the Local share toward the purchase of the replacement bus.

**ACCOUNT NUMBER:**

The funds for \$73,411 are budgeted in the Transit Operations account 564 47 4731001, and \$220,871 are in account 567 45 4598243.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

It is recommended that City Council approve the attached budget ordinance establishing \$710,282 for the FY23 Electric Bus Grant.
