B.1 2024-379 Budget Discussions

Interim City Manager Chris Wilson provided a brief overview.

First Tryon Advisors Managing Director, David Cheatwood made a PowerPoint Presentation (PPP); provided an overview of city ratings; spoke to the General Obligation bonds; to rating criteria; to analytical criteria; to demographics; to a financial profile; and to long term liability burdens.

Discussion took place regarding demographics; and credit ratings.

Water Resource Director Mike Borchers continued the PPP; outlined 2024 estimated debt capacity; spoke to budget development; to capital improvement program; to infrastructure deterioration; to regulatory compliance; to economic development and expansion; to rate increases; highlighted debt services; operating cost; capital projects; salaries; spoke to utilities; to fleet management; and to smart meters.

Discussion ensued regarding economic development; budget impact; solid waste and recycling; salary structure ratings; and parking rates.
