### **PURPOSE**:

An amendment to the Interlocal agreement to purchase water from the City of Reidsville is requested to renew the agreement for an additional five years.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The City of Reidsville and City of Greensboro originally entered into a water purchase agreement in May of 1999. This agreement formed the basis for the interconnection of the two respective communities' water and sewer systems. The agreement was renewed in September of 2009 with an expiration of June 30, 2014, and subsequently extended for an additional five years with an expiration of June 30, 2019. The last amendment extended the agreement until June 30, 2024. The proposed amendment extends the agreement an additional five years to June 30, 2029.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

The minimum purchase under this contract has a budget impact of approximately \$1,030,000 per year.
