**PURPOSE:**

The City of Greensboro as the designated recipient has received funds in the amount of \$470,311 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to support eligible expenses for the Federal Fiscal Year 2023 FTA Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program. A budget ordinance needs to be approved to accurately budget the expenditure of funds.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Section 5310 program supports projects that serve the special needs of transit dependent populations beyond traditional public transportation service, exceed the requirements of the ADA act, improve access to fixed route service and decrease reliance of complementary Paratransit service, and provide alternatives to public transportation. The Greensboro Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization conducted a competitive selection process for these funds. The Transportation Advisory Committee awarded funding to the City of Greensboro to support eligible operating expenses. The City of Greensboro will use Section 5310 funding in the amount of \$431,918 to provide early morning dialysis trips during weekdays and Saturdays. As the designated recipient for Section 5310 funds, the City of Greensboro is utilizing \$38,393 to support program administration costs, including administering the grant application and funding to the successful sub-recipient and ensuring that federal reporting requirements are met.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

The City will be required to provide local matching funds for \$86,383.
