PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro received a State Grant for \$94,000 for continuation of the NC Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) Team. A budget amendment needs to be approved by the City Council to permit the expenditure of funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Greensboro Fire Department's Urban Search and Rescue Team is funded by the State at \$94,000 per year to fund daily operations. The financial obligation by the State pays for training, administrative costs, equipment costs, medical, and workers compensation. The State provides response vehicles and equipment trailer to respond to search and rescue events. The program allows the GFD to enhance their response capabilities in terms of resources that benefit the citizens and businesses of Greensboro as well as the State of North Carolina.
