PURPOSE:

City Council approval is requested to convey a Permanent Drainage and Temporary Construction Easement to King's Cross Church of Greensboro, Inc for the installation of drainage piping and rip rap channel with a perpetual easement for use, maintenance, and repair of said drainage piping and channel at 1512 Gracewood Drive, Parcel #34733.

BACKGROUND:

The easements are granted across, through and under the property located at 1512 Gracewood Drive for purposes of constructing, operating, repairing and maintaining a below ground drainage pipe and rip rap channel which will connect into the existing creek located on the property. The purpose of this piping and channel is to provide a discharge location for a required sand filter stormwater control measure in compliance with Chapter 30, Article 12 of the City of Greensboro's Land Development Ordinance. The applicant has shown that no practical alternative exists to the discharge location without adversely affecting the applicant or the adjacent property.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The City of Greensboro will be dedicating the easement to King's Cross Church of Greensboro, Inc. so there will be no budget impact.
