PURPOSE:

A resolution is needed to authorize an Infrastructure Reimbursement Agreement in the amount of \$395,693 with Guilford County Board of Education.

BACKGROUND:

Project will allow for reimbursement to the Guilford County Board of Education the sum not to exceed \$395,693 for the construction of a right-turn lane on Josephine Boyd Street in conjunction with the Kiser Middle School Project. This reimbursement will be made pursuant to NCGS 160A-307.1 which requires that the cost of any required improvements to the municipal street system related to schools be reimbursed by the City.

A Traffic Impact Study for the redevelopment of Kiser Middle School identified the need for a right-turn lane on Southbound Josephine Boyd Street at Campus Drive. The proposed turn lane is incorporated in the school's construction plans and in accordance with NCGS 160A-307.1 the City is required to reimburse a school for municipal street improvements required by the City that are physically connected to a driveway on the school site and are required for safe ingress and egress to the City's municipal street system.

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

The project includes sidewalk, stormwater, curb ramps, curb and gutter and paving. In accordance with general statutes, the Guilford County Board of Education must advertise, bid, and award the construction contract in compliance with the public bidding requirements in NC General Statutes 143-29.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The City will reimburse the cost of this project an amount not to exceed \$395,693.

ACCOUNT NUMBER:

Funding for this project will come from 2016 Transportation Bond Fund account 481-45-4599174.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

It is recommended that City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing an Infrastructure Reimbursement Agreement in the amount of \$395,693 with the Guilford County Board of Education.
