PURPOSE:

The Greensboro Parks and Recreation Department has received a grant in the amount of \$2,500 from the Carolina Panthers to provide funding to support the department's implementation of the 2024 Challenger Football program for youth and adults with disabilities. To accept this grant, a budget amendment is requested from Greensboro City Council in accordance with current city fiscal procedures.

BACKGROUND:

The Challenger Football Program will allow for Greensboro Parks and Recreation to continue to provide an inclusive sports program so that individuals of all abilities can participate and learn the fundamentals of football. Acceptance of this grant allows the City to continue its outreach and commitment to providing adaptive and inclusive recreation opportunities. The department's Adaptive and Inclusive Recreation (AIR) section is partnering with Kernersville Parks and Recreation, High Point Parks and Recreation, and the Arc of Greensboro to offer the program.

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

BUDGET IMPACT:

No match is required from the City to secure this grant and this program will not impact the Parks and Recreation budget. In order to provide a more inclusive experience in football for those with disabilities, the Parks and Recreation Department will use the \$2,500 grant to provide all program supplies needed to operate the program and the post-season awards and banquet.
