PURPOSE:

A resolution needs to be approved to authorize agreement in the amount of \$510,000 to Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Update.

BACKGROUND:

The Greensboro Department of Transportation recommends the award of the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan under Task Order #2 of the Master Agreement with Stantec Consulting Services for federally funded transportation professional services. The Master Agreement was executed on December 1, 2023 following a competitive process that included GDOT, E&I, M/WBE, and NCDOT personnel. The contract provides for Stantec to develop the Greensboro Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). The MTP will provide a comprehensive review of project and program recommendations, and fulfill a range of federal and state regulatory requirements. The Metropolitan Transportation Plan must be completed by December 2025 per federal regulatory requirements.

As a federally-funded NCDOT supported professional services contract under the MPO Planning Work program, this solicitation is governed by federal requirements, and City M/WBE goals do not apply. The contractor has secured participation by DBE certified firms totaling 16.6% of the contract value (Just Cities Collective 8.3% and Foursquare ITP 8.3%).

BUDGET IMPACT:

The 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) Update cost is not to exceed \$510,000. The project will be funded utilizing previously approved MPO funds.

ACCOUNT NUMBER:

The project is funded from State, Federal, and Other Grants Fund using FY 25 MPO Grant funds in account 220-45-4598269.5413.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

It is recommended that City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing agreement in the amount of \$510,000 to Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. for 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Update.
