## **PURPOSE**:

Water Resources Department is requesting approval for an engineering services contract for Construction Administration and Resident Project Representation for the T.Z. Osborne Influent Pumps Replacement Project. City Council approval of a contract with Arcadis G&M of North Carolina, Inc. in the amount of \$608,515 is requested.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requires construction administration and project construction inspections for an upcoming T.Z. Osborne Water Reclamation Facility project. The project replaces aged equipment associated with and including the four primary influent pumps. Arcadis is the Engineer of Record for the design and will provide the engineering support services.

Arcadis G&M of North Carolina, Inc. is also on the City of Greensboro Water Resources On-Call list and was selected in accordance with the Mini-Brooks Act for Engineering Services. The team assembled by Arcadis G&M of North Carolina, Inc. includes CriTek Engineering Group, a local MBE firm for 2.04% and CITI, Inc., a local MWBE for 7.65%, and Taylor Engineering & Consulting, PLLC, a local WBE for 22.59%.
