PURPOSE:

Zachary E. Sharp for Cipriano Berrospe Cabrera, Jose Luis Berrospes-Bustos and Cipriano Berrospe-Bustos, is requesting rezoning from LI (Light Industrial) to **C-M** (Commercial Medium) for a portion of 2645 Randleman Road, generally described as east of Randleman Road and north of Corliss Street.

Because the Planning and Zoning Commission's approved this request with less than 6 favorable votes, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and take action on this request at its **October 15, 2024** meeting.

BACKGROUND:

Following a public hearing on September 16, 2024, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted 5-4 to recommend approval of this request. There was one speaker in favor and one in opposition for this item. (See minutes of the September 16, 2024 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting).

Since the Planning and Zoning Commission approved this request with less than 6 favorable votes, the City Council must hold an additional public hearing and take final action.
