PURPOSE:

The Greensboro Public Library has received a reimbursement grant from the State Library of North Carolina, in the amount of \$1,734 for a continuing education scholarship to the Core Forum 2024 event. To accept this reimbursement grant, a budget amendment is requested from Greensboro City Council in accordance with current city fiscal procedures.

BACKGROUND:

The State Library of North Carolina awarded federal funds under the Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA). Under the Scholarship Grant the Library was allocated \$1,734 in federal funds to support eligible costs associated with the Collections Development and Information Services Manager attending the Core Forum 2024 Continuing Education Event.

The fund provided will reimburse the City of Greensboro for expenses incurred by the Library to facilitate allowable travel expenses for staff attendance at Core Forum 2024. Core Forum 2024 provides the opportunity to attend two chosen session tracks, Leadership & Management and Metadata & Collections, which will help foster the continuing education of the manager.

BUDGET IMPACT:

No match required from the City to secure this grant.
