PURPOSE:

The Greensboro Police Department has been awarded a Homeland Security Grant from North Carolina Emergency Management (NCEM) for \$85,000. A budget ordinance is needed to accept the award.

BACKGROUND:

The North Carolina Emergency Management (NCEM) has awarded the Greensboro Police Department \$85,000 through the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP). It is a three year grant that will become effective upon the execution of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the agencies. The grant will be used to purchase portable barricade systems. The department purchased such barricades with their FY22 and FY23 HSGP grants. The vehicle barriers allow officers to secure areas from on-coming traffic. Such areas would include outdoor public events, areas requiring a robust, secure perimeter or areas stricken by natural disasters.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The grant does not require additional City funds.
