PURPOSE:

The Greensboro Police Department has been awarded a Homeland Security Grant from North Carolina Emergency Management (NCEM) for \$25,000. A budget ordinance is needed to accept the award.

BACKGROUND:

The North Carolina Emergency Management (NCEM) has awarded the Greensboro Police Department \$25,000 through the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP). The grant that will become effective upon the execution of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the agencies. The grant will be used to purchase a mobile security camera trailer that will assist the department's Real Time Crime Center.
