PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department wishes to establish grant funding from the NC Department of Environmental Quality Division of Water Infrastructure for a Sewer Asset Inventory and Assessment study. Council approval is requested for a budget ordinance to permit the expenditure of funds.

BACKGROUND:

On May 16, 2023, the City of Greensboro City Council approved resolution 108-23 authorizing the acceptance of grant funding from the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality Division of Water Infrastructure for a Sewer Asset Inventory and Assessment study. This ordinance appropriates the funds and establishes the account structure for the grant.

BUDGET IMPACT:

This amendment will increase the Water Resources Grant Fund budget by \$400,000.
