PURPOSE:

A resolution needs to be approved to authorize a Municipal Agreement with NC Department of Transportation for EB-5996 North Church Street Modernization Project.

BACKGROUND:

Project EB-5996 will add sidewalks and bicycle lanes on North Church Street between Electra Drive and Lees Chapel Road. The project will improve safety, convenience, accessibility, and comfort for residents in the corridor. The project will also add enhanced bus shelter amenities along GTA Route 3, including for the Henry Street Medical Park and multiple residential neighborhoods.

Federal funding for the project will cover 80% of estimated construction, engineering, and right-of-way costs. The Municipal Agreement specifies the amounts and the steps the City must follow to receive the funding.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Project will be funded as follows:

\$3,542,600 Federal Funds (80%)

\$ 885,650 Local Bond Funds (20%)
\$4,428,250
