PURPOSE:

A budget ordinance needs to be approved to increase the budget for Supplemental Agreement #1 with NCDOT for EB-6033AI Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure Grant.

BACKGROUND:

Project EB-6033AI provides for the City of Greensboro to receive a grant of federal Safe Routes to School funds over a two year period starting in fall 2023. This grant supports programming for students in grades K-12, including the development of education, encouragement, enforcement, and evaluation strategies to increase the safety and convenience for students to walk and/or bicycle to school. Installation of bicycle racks and minor school-related crosswalk and sidewalk infrastructure repairs and modernization are also eligible under the program.

BUDGET IMPACT:

This project will be funded as follows:

\$125,595 Federal Funds <u>\$ 31,399</u> Local Funds \$156,994
