PURPOSE:

City Council is requested to approve a budget ordinance to appropriate insurance claim revenue funds received from FM Global in the amount of \$10,000 to be distributed for the court replacement of the Sportsplex.

BACKGROUND:

On July 5, 2024 a storm in the Greensboro area caused wind damage to several City of Greensboro properties including the Greensboro Sportsplex roof which was in the process of being replaced. The damage to the roof caused leaks leading to moisture damage to several courts. FM Global insurance company agreed to reimburse the City for the court repair expenses in the initial amount of \$268,887. In October 2024, an ACH was issued to the City and deposited into a Sportsplex revenue account. In February 2025, FM Global insurance company agreed to reimburse the City an additional \$10,000. An ACH was issued to the City and the funding was deposited into the Sportsplex revenue account.

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

Due to the event being unanticipated, funding was not allocated in the current fiscal year. The Parks and Recreation Sportsplex division is requesting to utilize the insurance refund from the replacement of the damaged courts.

BUDGET IMPACT:

There is no negative impact on the departmental operating budget. The adopted resolution provides for revenue funds from an insurance claim refund to be utilized for replacing the damage of the courts.
