PURPOSE:

To provide consistency between these ordinance provisions, the attached amendment ordinance will increase the fine stated in Section 16-165 of the Greensboro Code of Ordinances to FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50).

BACKGROUND:

Section 16-71(a) of the Greensboro Code of Ordinances states “[f]or unlawful front yard parking (subsection 16-73(a) (22), there shall be a fixed civil penalty charge in the amount of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00).” Section 16-165 of the Greensboro Code of Ordinances provides for a fine of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) for a front yard parking violation.
