SUBJECT: M/WBE Memo for the Resurfacing of Streets 2024-25
Contract #12299 (2024-001)-Change Order #1

The M/WBE Office reviewed the documentation submitted by Blythe Construction, Inc. to determine continued compliance with the M/WBE Program Plan. The Plan requires the Prime contractor to maintain the M/WBE commitment and provide M/WBE subcontractors the opportunity to perform the change order work if the work items are already included in their subcontract or the work is materially the same. The current value of the contract is \$9,665,285.77, and the M/WBE commitment is MBE 10.5% and WBE 21.5%.

Change Order #1 (\$4,800,000.00) will increase the total contract value to \$14,465,285.77. The change order will include additional streets, ADA-compliant curb ramps, concrete islands, and pavement marking improvements identified throughout the city. Blythe Construction, Inc. will maintain its M/WBE commitment utilizing the following certified M/WBE firms:
