**PURPOSE:**

A resolution needs to be approved to authorize Supplemental Agreement #2 with NC Department of Transportation for EB-5877 Farmington Drive Sidewalk Project.

**BACKGROUND:**

Project EB-5877 will construct sidewalks on Farmington Drive from Gate City Boulevard to Holden Road. The project will improve pedestrian safety, accessibility, and mobility, and connect residents to transit, retail businesses and to Smith High School. City staff is in the process of completing right-of-way acquisition for the project, and the project is anticipated to be advertised for construction during the Summer of 2025.

Supplemental Agreement #2 extends the timeline for completing the project 3 years beyond the current agreement date of July 1, 2025 allowing adequate time to complete the construction and close out the project. This agreement has no budgetary impact.
