**PURPOSE:**

Michael Praylor, or Praylor Construction Company, Inc., is requesting original zoning from **County RS-40** (Residential Single Family) to **City R-5** (Residential Single Family -5) for 1606 Youngs Mill Road, generally described as south of Youngs Mill Road and east of Circlevue Drive.

As this request is associated with a voluntary annexation petition, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and take action on this request at its **April 15, 2025** meeting.

**BACKGROUND:**

Following a public hearing on March 17, 2025, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted 9-0 to recommend approval of this request. There were no speakers for this item. (See minutes of the March 17, 2025 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting). This request is associated with a voluntary annexation petition to access City services for new residential development.
