PURPOSE:

Harmonic Brass REI, LP, for Daniel and James Kent, is requesting annexation of the property located at 4115 Corbin Road, generally described as west of Corbin Road and west of US Highway 29.

As this request is a voluntary annexation petition, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and take action on this request at its **May 20, 2025** meeting.

BACKGROUND:

The property is located within the Tier 1 Growth Area on the Growth Strategies Map in the Comprehensive Plan.

City water is available by connecting to the eight inch water line located on the west side of Corbin Road.

City sewer is available by connecting to the eight inch sewer outfall that runs through the east side of the subject property.

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

The City's Fire Department notes that this site is currently served by Fire District 13, Station 55 on Hicone Road (northeast of the request). Upon annexation, Fire District 13, Station 55 will continue to serve the property based on a longstanding monetary contract. The City Fire Department can meet the Standard of Cover to this location with existing stations and personnel.

The Police Department can provide service to the site with no effect. The Police Department can provide comparable response service to the property under consideration as of the date of annexation. Additional resources may be required as development on the subject property and/or additional annexation in the general area occurs.

City Solid Waste can provide collection services to this location.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Initial service will be absorbed in the budget; future services will have an incremental effect on future budgets.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

The Technical Review Committee (TRC) recommended this annexation to the Planning and Zoning Commission and to City Council at its February 4, 2025 meeting

The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of this annexation at its April 21, 2025 meeting on a vote of 8-0 and the meeting minutes are included with the associated zoning item.

Accordingly, it is recommended that City Council hold a public hearing to receive public comment and to consider adoption of an ordinance annexing the above-mentioned property into the City of Greensboro.
