PURPOSE:

Nicholas Riggings, for Harmonic Brass REI LP for Daniel and James Kent, is requesting original zoning from **County RS-30** (Residential Single Family) to **City CD-RM-18** (Conditional District Residential Multi-family - 18) for 4115 Corbin Road, generally described as west of Corbin Road and west of US Highway 29.

As this request is associated with a voluntary annexation petition, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and take action on this request at its **May 20, 2025** meeting.

BACKGROUND:

Following a public hearing on April 21, 2025, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted 8-0 to recommend approval of this request. There were no speakers for this item. (See minutes of the April 21, 2025 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting). This request is associated with a voluntary annexation petition to access City services for new residential development.

This request includes the following conditions:

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

1. Uses shall be limited to: A maximum of 70 residential dwelling units.
2. Maximum building height shall not exceed 25 feet
3. A 6-foot tall opaque fence shall be provided along any property line directly abutting existing residential uses.
