PURPOSE:

The purpose of this interlocal contract is for supplemental fire protection in annexed areas of the City of Greensboro provided by FD #13, INC.

BACKGROUND:

There exist annexed areas of the City of Greensboro that current Greensboro Fire Department (GFD) fire station locations cannot meet the standard of coverage. The Greensboro Fire Department has had an interlocal agreement for over 20 years to provide service to areas that city fire stations cannot meet the standard of coverage.
