PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro and Guilford County are partners in a housing consortium to receive federal HOME program funding from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

BACKGROUND:

The City of Greensboro serves as the Lead Entity of the Greensboro HOME Consortium, and has the authority to disperse HUD HOME funds to consortium members. In 2024, the City of Burlington and Alamance County separated from the Greensboro HOME Consortium to form their own, leaving the City of Greensboro and Guilford County as remaining members of the Greensboro HOME Consortium. The Greensboro HOME Consortium will renew for the three-year Consortium qualification period 2025-2027 beginning July 1, 2025 ending June 30, 2028.

The City of Greensboro and Guilford County will take actions to approve the Interlocal Joint Cooperative Agreement for the Greensboro HOME Consortium.
