## RESOLUTION APPROVING AN ANCILLARY INTERGOVERNMENTAL WATER SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE WINSTON-SALEM / FORSYTH COUNTY UTILITY COMMISSION FOR THE PURCHASE OF TREATED DRINKING WATER

WHEREAS, the City of Greensboro and Winston-Salem / Forsyth County Utility Commission have a long history of collaborating and supporting each other through a mutually beneficial treated water distribution system interconnection;

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2002 the Winston-Salem / Forsyth County Utility Commission and City of Greensboro entered into an ancillary intergovernmental water services agreement for the purchase of up to 3 million gallons per day (MGD) of treated drinking water.

WHEREAS, the ancillary intergovernmental water services agreement formed the basis for the interconnection of the two respective communities' water systems;

WHEREAS, the City of Greensboro desires to support Winston-Salem / Forsyth County Utility Commission's request to amend the ancillary intergovernmental agreement for the purpose of standardizing commission's intergovernmental agreements;

WHEREAS, the City of Greensboro acknowledges sone water distribution system improvements are required to ensure Winston-Salem / Forsyth County Utility Commission can consistently provide the 3MGD flow rate referenced by the agreement;

WHEREAS, continuation of the agreement with the agreed upon amended changes provides Greensboro the benefit of supporting regional economic development opportunities in the western part of the city;

WHEREAS, with the adoption of this resolution, the City Manager is authorized to execute pursuant to the requirements of Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, an amendment to the Ancillary Intergovernmental Water Services Agreement with Winston-Salem / Forsyth County Utility Commission for the purchase of treated drinking water; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBORO:

That, pursuant to Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, the City Manager is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Greensboro, an amendment to the Ancillary Intergovernmental Water Services Agreement with Winston-Salem / Forsyth County Utility Commission for the purchase of treated drinking water.
