PURPOSE:

An ordinance needs to be approved to establish the budget or AARP Community Challenge Capacity-Building Microgrant to support walk audits in Northeast Greensboro.

BACKGROUND:

The AARP Community Challenge provides small grants to fund quick-action projects to make communities more livable. The program has awarded a \$2,500 microgrant to the City to support two walk audits in the vicinity of E. Cone Boulevard and Summit Avenue in Northeast Greensboro. Grant activities must be completed by December 2025.

GDOT will work with local community volunteers to identify accessibility, safety, and maintenance challenges along pedestrian routes in the neighborhood with a special focus on the needs of residents aged 50 or older. While the grant agreement does not require matching funds, the City will support the two walk audits with in-kind support including planning and engineering staff time, safety vests, traffic cones, and other items and services.
