

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GRANT AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500  
WITH AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF RETIRED PERSONS FOR COMMUNITY  
CHALLENGE CAPACITY-BUILDING MICROGRANT**

WHEREAS, the AARP Community Challenge program provides small grants to support quick-action projects that enhance community livability for residents of all ages;

WHEREAS, the City of Greensboro has been awarded a Community Challenge Capacity-Building Microgrant to conduct two walk audits in the vicinity of East Cone Boulevard and Summit Avenue in Northeast Greensboro;

WHEREAS, the Greensboro Department of Transportation (GDOT) will use the grant funds to work with local community volunteers to identify accessibility, safety, and maintenance challenges along pedestrian routes in the neighborhood, with a focus on the needs of residents aged 50 and older; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBORO:

That the City Council hereby formally approves the project and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Grant Agreement with the American Association of Retired Persons for the Community Challenge Capacity-Building Microgrant.
