PURPOSE:

On October 1, 2019, the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the County of Guilford, the City of High Point and the Town of Gibsonville to document their understanding for involuntary commitments and transportation. The four law enforcement agencies have updated the Interlocal Agreement and City Council is being requested to approve the updated Interlocal Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to NC General Statute 122C-251, the law enforcement agencies in Guilford County entered into an agreement for transportation of respondents in involuntary commitment proceedings and the agreement was approved by City Council at the October 15, 2019 council meeting (19- 0680). The four agencies now wish to update the Interlocal Agreement to clarify and update the duties and responsibilities of each jurisdiction in relation to the involuntary commitment process.
