PURPOSE:

City of Greensboro is requesting original zoning from **County RM-8** (Residential Multi-family) to **City R-5** (Residential Single Family - 5) for the eastern portion of Willow Road Right of Way adjacent to 2023 and 2069 Willow Road, generally described as north of Rotherwood Road and south of Terre Court.

As this request is associated with a voluntary annexation petition, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and take action on this request at its **July 15, 2025** meeting.

BACKGROUND:

Following a public hearing on June 16, 2025, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted 8-0 to recommend approval of this request. There were no speakers for this item. (See minutes of the June 16, 2025 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting). This request is associated with a voluntary annexation petition to annex public rights of way adjacent to new community serving residential, office and services development.
