### **PURPOSE:**

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requests to appropriate bond funding for the Water Resources Capital Project Revenue Bond Fund budget for the Lees Chapel Road Water Line Project. Council approval is requested for a budget ordinance to permit the expenditure of funds.

### **BACKGROUND:**

This project provides transmission of finished water from Townsend Water Treatment Plant to Brightwood School Road through approximately 18,500 LF of 36-inch water line. Water main connections will be made at Bryan Park Drive and Rudd Station Road to provide redundancy for water supply to large commercial users. The project will improve resiliency of the water distribution system in northern Greensboro.

### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

This amendment will increase the Water Resources Bond Fund budget by \$23,425,866 from revenue bond funding.
