PURPOSE:

Rescind a Council Resolution to install 1,445 linear feet of 8 inch sewer line from an existing outfall on Little Santee Road to 8923 West Market Street. The sewer route that was originally proposed in very preliminary phases of engineering was not feasible and an alternative solution was selected. This was very challenging to service with sewer and the best alternative selected was property acquisition which eliminated the sewer.

BACKGROUND:

On November 15, 2022, City Council authorized the installation of 1,445 linear feet of 8 inch sewer line extension from an existing outfall on Little Santee Road to 8923 West Market Street due to a failed septic system. The area for service has multiple challenges including capacity, slope and depth of lines, and railroad and highway right-of-ways. The engineering analysis for service to this site determined the extension was not needed and an alternative alignment to service for this area was selected.
