#### **PURPOSE**:

The bids for Contract 2017-020A, Lees Chapel Road Feeder Main Project, have been received. In order for the work to proceed on this contract, City Council approval is requested for award of the contract to Jimmy R. Lynch & Sons, Inc. for \$23,425,866.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Work to be performed under this contract consists of the installation of approximately 18,545 L.F. of 36" water line, 43 LF of 16" water line; 970 L.F. of 12" water line; 352 L.F. of 8" water line; 180 L.F. of 18" steel encasement, 60 L.F. of 24" steel encasement, and 270 L.F. of 54" steel encasement to be installed by boring and jacking method. These lines are to be installed along Lees Chapel Road and Townsend Road from Brightwood School Road to the Townsend Water Treatment Plant.

The bids were opened on May 22, 2025, and the apparent lowest, responsive bidder was Jimmy R. Lynch & Sons, Inc. with a bid of \$23,425,866. The MWBE goals for this project are 15.5% MBE and 24.5% WBE. The contractor's commitments are 0.99% MBE and 8.75% WBE. Due to the fact the MWBE goals were not met by either bidder, a Good Faith Effort (GFE) review

was conducted by the MWBE Department. Their review concluded that Jimmy R. Lynch & Sons, Inc. did demonstrate sufficient Good Faith Efforts.

The other bids received were: Mainlining America, LLC \$29,871,334.00 MBE = 18.10% WBE = 14.11% Livingston, NJ

The GFE review determined that Mainlining America, LLC did not demonstrate sufficient good faith efforts. Due to the fact this bid was bifurcated, an appeal to this determination was made by Mainlining America, LLC, and an appeal hearing was conducted. This appeal resulted in the original GFE review determination being overturned.

The proposed date for start of construction is September 2025. The proposed date of completion is July 2027.
