SUBJECT: M/WBE Memo for Contract 2017-020A Lees Chapel Feeder Main

The M/WBE Office reviewed the documentation submitted for the Contract 2017-020A Lees Chapel Feeder Main Project to determine compliance with the City of Greensboro M/WBE Program Plan. The goals established for the project were MBE 15.50% and WBE 24.50%. JR Lynch & Sons achieved MBE 0.99% and WBE 8.75%. The company did not meet the M/WBE goals; however, it achieved Good Faith Efforts.

JR Lynch committed to subcontract MBE \$234,916.08 and WBE \$2,049,763.27 of the total contract value of \$23,425,865.93 to the following certified M/WBE firms:
