PURPOSE:

This purpose of adopting the Guilford County Hazard Mitigation plan is for the city of Greensboro to comply with Federal hazard mitigation requirements.

BACKGROUND:

Congress passed Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 for jurisdictions to develop a Hazard Mitigation Plan in order for jurisdictions to be eligible to receive federal approved funds for hazard mitigation and for disaster recovery. Without an adopted plan, the City of Greensboro would not be eligible for federally approved funds.
