PURPOSE:

An ordinance needs to be approved to increase the budget for Supplemental Agreement #3 with NC Department of Transportation for EB-5877 Farmington Drive Sidewalks.

BACKGROUND:

Project EB-5877 will construct sidewalks on Farmington Drive from Gate City Boulevard to Holden Road. The project will improve pedestrian safety, accessibility, and mobility, and connect residents to transit, retail businesses and to Smith High School. NCDOT agreed to reimburse the City for 80% of eligible design, right-of-way, and construction costs after the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) submitted the project for consideration under the Prioritization 4.0 project selection process.

This project was recently put out to bid and based on the low bid that was received, NCDOT has agreed to increase funding for the project to maintain an 80% federal funding share. Supplemental Agreement #3 provides for NCDOT to reimburse the City an additional \$95,700 in federal funds with the city providing an additional \$23,900 in local matching funds.

BUDGET IMPACT:

This supplemental agreement will increase funding as follows:
