**PURPOSE:**

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requests to appropriate bond funding for the Water Resources Capital Project Revenue Bond Fund budget for the Townsend Water Treatment Plant advanced treatment facility design/build project. Council approval is requested for a budget ordinance to permit the expenditure of funds.

**BACKGROUND:**

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requested and received approval from City Council to use the Design Build Alternative Delivery method for construction of the Townsend Water Treatment Plant Advanced Treatment Facility to address emerging contaminants at the City Council meeting on September 16, 2025, Resolution 250-25. The project will address per- and polyflouroalkyl (PFAS) substances within the City’s source water.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

This amendment will increase the Water Resources Bond Fund budget by \$35,095,232 from revenue bond funding.
