**PURPOSE:**

The City of Greensboro is the grantee for the federal Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) grant for the Eligible Metropolitan Statistical Area which serves Guilford, Randolph and Rockingham Counties. Central Carolina Health Network (CCHN) has been selected by the State of North Carolina to coordinate the network of care services for persons living with HIV/AIDS for the Piedmont-Triad region. City Council approval is requested to increase funding to contract #12891 in the amount of \$155,000, for a total contract amount of \$605,000, with CCHN for HOPWA program administration and housing services.

**BACKGROUND:**

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) allocates annual awards based on HIV/AIDS incidence data from the Center for Disease Control. The HOPWA program addresses the housing needs of low-income persons (below 80% Area Median Income) living with HIV/AIDS and their families. Eligible Housing-related services include supportive services, tenant-based rental assistance, short-term rent, mortgage and utility assistance, permanent housing placement assistance, housing information assistance and resource identification services.

Federal HOPWA funds in the amount of \$155,000 will be used to fund recommended change order.
