PURPOSE:

Approve four agreements with Duke Power and the expenditure of \$111,481.59 in Municipal Service District funds.

BACKGROUND:

Work to be performed under these Agreements consists of the replacement of 51 decorative streetlights in the College Hill Historic District. MSD funds are being used to cover the replacement cost for working fixtures, ensuring that the lights throughout College Hill have a uniform appearance. The existing decorative streetlights were installed in the 1980s and have reached the end of their serviceable life. Parts for repair are no longer available. The College Hill Neighborhood Association approved this expense of their Municipal Service District funds at their meeting on January 26, 2026. The Historic Preservation Commission held a public hearing and passed a motion in favor of the streetlight replacement project at their meeting on February 26, 2026. The streetlights will be replaced in four phases as shown on the [map on the back of the agreements](#). Work is expected to start on July 1, 2026 and will be completed by October 1, 2026.

Cost for all four phases is \$111,481.59
