

RESOLUTION APPROVING LIGHTING SERVICE AGREEMENTS WITH DUKE ENERGY
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$111,481.59 FOR THE COLLEGE HILL MUNICIPAL SERVICE
DISTRICT STREETLIGHT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, Duke Energy has proposed four Lighting Service Agreements to replace a total of 51 decorative streetlights in the College Hill Historic District;

WHEREAS, the decorative streetlights scheduled for replacement under these Agreements are functional but can no longer be repaired because of their age;

WHEREAS, after consultation and discussions among the College Hill Neighborhood Association (CHNA), the Greensboro Departments of Transportation and Planning, and Duke Energy, CHNA voted to proceed with the replacement of decorative streetlights at their meeting on February 24, 2025;

WHEREAS, at their meeting on January 26, 2026, CHNA voted to approve the use of \$111,481.59 in Municipal Service Districts funds to pay for streetlight replacement;

WHEREAS, after due notice, the Greensboro Historic Preservation Commission conducted a public hearing on the Agreements on February 25, 2026, and unanimously voted to recommend that City Council accept the Agreements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBORO:

That the Lighting Service Agreements hereinabove mentioned are accepted, and the City is authorized to enter into the Agreements with Duke Energy for the College Hill Municipal Service District Streetlight Replacement Project. The City Manager is hereby authorized execute the Agreements on behalf of the City of Greensboro.
